

### Strategy Gaps

- Pacing
- Guessing penalty

### Content Gaps

- Historical minutiae: people, legislation, events, literary works, terminology, and court cases
- Greater depth in certain periods: Industrial Revolution and Post-1968 America
- Structures of government and the Constitution

## IB History (HL) Course with Depth Study in History of the Americas



### Strategy Gaps

- Answering multiple-choice questions: fact-based and source-based (quotes, cartoons, maps, graphs)
- Pacing
- Guessing penalty

### Content Gaps

- All content 1400 - 1880
- Greater depth and focus on U.S. 1880 - Present
- Structures of government and the Constitution
- Supreme Court cases and decisions
